Young Horse/Sport Horse Classes - Qualifier Show

Class 2: Yearling Fillies (born in 2003)

Class 5: Cosequin/USDFBC Rocky Mountain Qualifier Filly Championship
1st two places from classes 1, 2, 3, 4 (no class fee)

Class 6: Colts of 2004, with or without dam, foals only to be judged

Class 7: Yearling Colts and Geldings (born in 2003)

Class 8: Two Year old Colts and Geldings (born in 2002)

Class 9: Three Year Old Colts and Geldings (born in 2001)

Class 10: Cosequin/USDFBC Rocky Mountain Qualifier Colt/Gelding
Championship 1st two places from classes 6, 7, 8, 9 (no class fee)

- * * For competition purposes, a mare's breeding status on January 1 will remain the same until December 31 of the same calendar year. USEF Federation Rulebook Art. 1937.9 (i.e. a mare that is in foal or nursing will remain a broodmare for competition purposes after the foal is weaned, regardless of her actual breeding status, until December 31 of the same year. If she is not in foal on January 1...she will remain a yeld or maiden mare for competition purposes throughout the year, even if successfully re-bred throughout the year.)

OUALIFYING FOR BREED CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

NOTE: The open breed show is a qualifier for the Cosequin ®/USDF Breeders' Championships – Rocky Mountain Series Final as well as for the RMDS Sport horse Breeding Championship 2004

To qualify for the Cosequin®/USDF Breeders' Championships – Rocky Mountain Series Final: Horses that have been Champion or Reserve Champion Filly, Colt/Gelding, Mare or Stallion at any qualifying show (including this Open Show) are automatically qualified to enter the Cosequin®/USDF Breeder's Championships. Third place horses are also invited to attend if the Champion or Reserve have previously qualified. See the current RMDS Omnibus for a list of qualifying shows for this year.

To qualify for RMDS Sport horse Breeding Championships: the first and second place horse from any RMDS recognized sport horse breeding class (including this Open Show) is eligible to attend the RMDS Sport horse Breeding Championships in that class. The horse, owner and handler must be RMDS members in good standing at the time the placing was earned.

All horses entered in any Cosequin®/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Qualifier show must either be registered with USDF or pay a \$20.00 lifetime USDF Identification Number Fee, and submit identification information and (if available) a copy of the registry papers directly to USDF or to the first USDFBC Qualifying Event that they enter. Any horse participating in the Series Final classes must be Life registered with USDF. The Horse Identification Number Fee will apply toward the (lifetime) USDF Horse Registration Fee. Prize money and awards may be withheld by USDF to Series winners if the following information is not provided to USDF or show management prior to reporting or competition deadlines: name of horse, sex, age of horse, (also, if known, the sire, dam, dam sire, and breeder), handler and owner.

Breed Show Fees:

- Breed show open classes \$25 per class all classes except call back classes 5, 10, 11, 14, 16, 17, 18, 31.
- RMDS Championship Breed Classes 23, 24 \$30 per class.
- RMDS Grand Champion Class #25 no fee
- Cosequin ®/USDF Breeders' Championship classes 19, 20, 21, 22 \$30 per class.
- Office fee \$40 per breed show entry. \$10 per entry if received after Sept.16.
- All **USEF fees are applicable.** Refund policy and stabling fees are stated earlier in the prize list.
- 2004 Coggins required on horses 1 year and older.

Awards:

- Ribbons to 6th place for the open show classes, champion and reserve champion ribbons for call back classes.
- Open Show classes 1st place trophies.
- RMDS Sport horse Breeding Championships neck ribbon to champion and reserve champion, trophy for champion.
- Cosequin/USDF Qualifier neck ribbons to the Champion and Reserve Champion of the four Qualifier classes.
- Cosequin ®/USDF Breeders' Series Championship neck ribbon, plaque, and embroidered cooler to each champion and neck ribbon and plaque to each reserve champion.
