OPEN SHOW INFORMATION

- In the Musical Freestyle Test of Choice be sure to list level on entry and include copy of 58% or better technical test.
- Open show classes/divisions with less than 4 entries may be canceled or combined.
- Management will do its best to schedule specified Open classes before Championship classes where appropriate.

<u>Great America/USDF Region V 2005 Championships Qualifying Dates</u>: (10/5/2004 – 8/25/2005) Please check the front of the Omnibus for the 2005 Qualifying and Championship Rules, Procedures and Eligibility Requirements.

Qualifying For 2005 Rmds Championships Qualifying Dates: 10/01/04-9/25/05

- You need two qualifying scores, two different judges, and from two different shows, per level, see RMDS Standing Rules section XIV "Championship Show" paragraph B-4c for scores required.
 - Please Note: "These scores may be from any test at the specified level" (sec. XIV B-4a).
 - Scores from RMDS recognized shows October 1, 2004-September 25, 2005
- You may attempt to earn your last qualifying score in the Open section of the Championship show (see sec. XIV B-1).
 - However, you MUST send in your championship entry form complete with entry in the Championship class you intend to qualify for on or before the Championship show closing date (see sec. XIV B-2).
- If you do *not* earn your final score in the Open section of the Championship show you will **NOT** get a refund for the RMDS Championship class not qualified for (see sec. XIV B-3).

- Please note that RMDS Championship class rides DO count towards USDF year-end awards, not for USDF Regional Championship Qualifying. If you want these scores to count, you must be eligible for USDF Year End Awards (USDF Participating Membership and USDF Lifetime Horse Registration).
- Note that RMDS Championship scores DO count towards RMDS 2005 Year End Awards (see sec. XIV A-2).

RMDS CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

For your convenience we have printed selected sections of the current RMDS Standing Rules below:

- Horse/rider combinations may compete in Championship Classes at a Maximum of 2 levels, which must be sequential (sec. XIV A-3).
- For Training through Fourth Level Championship Classes, horse/rider combinations are not eligible to compete in any Championship Classes if they have previously participated in any RMDS, USEF or USDF recognized competition at two or more levels higher. For FEI Championship Classes, horse/rider combinations may have previously competed at any FEI level (sec. XIV A-4).
- Horse/rider combinations that are champions from previous years for Training Level through Fourth Level are not eligible to compete again in Championship Classes at the same level at which they were champions (sec. XIV A-5).
- Except for Musical Freestyle classes, the annual level champions for Adult Amateur, Junior/Young Rider, and Open divisions will be determined by riding the highest test at the level, which shall be judged by at least two judges. The horse/rider combination with the highest average for each division at the level shall be champions (sec. XIV A-6).
- Musical Freestyle Level Champions shall be determined by riding a single freestyle test at the qualified level that shall be judged by at least two (2) judges. The horse/rider combination with the highest average score for the test at each level shall be the Champion (sec. XIV A-7).
- Only the rider that has qualified on a specific horse may ride that qualified horse during the Championship show (groom with loose rein excepted). (Sec. XIV A-8). Only one rider per horse for the entire show.
- The championship awards will be presented at the Championship show in a formal awards ceremony.
 Failure of horse and rider recipients to appear in show dress and full tack for the ceremony (unless excused for cause by the show management) shall result in immediate disqualification. In event of disqualification, each affected award shall be presented to the next lower average score (sec. XIV A-9).
- A rider in an RMDS Championship class may not carry a whip. (Exception: Riders riding sidesaddle may carry a whip in RMDS Championships). (Sec. XIV A-10)..
- Championship tests must be ridden from memory (sec. XIV A-11). No callers allowed.
- Rider must submit a copy of their current USEF Adult Amateur card to be eligible to ride as an Adult Amateur (sec. XIV A-12).

RMDS CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

RMDS Champions awarded a trophy and neck ribbon, Reserve Champions awarded a neck ribbon, ribbons through eighth place. In case of a tie in RMDS Championship classes, the management will follow the tiebreaking policy for USDF Regional Championships classes.

RMDS FUTURITY:

- Nominate your horse for the 2005 Futurity!
- No advance nominations are necessary, just mail in your completed nomination form with futurity fees along with your entry form and appropriate class and show entry fees for the 2 futurity classes.
- Be sure to enter the appropriate two Futurity classes: classes 312 and 412
- The futurity is open to all horses six years and younger who have not shown above First Level.
- Futurity Nominating Fee: \$35 per horse.
- Prize money will be awarded to Champion and Reserve on a 60/40 split.
- Run under Championship rules.
- No prior Futurity Champion may enter.

Management Rules and Procedures

- Classes designated RMDS Championship classes shall be open ONLY to individual horse/rider
 combinations meeting the criteria described in the RMDS Standing Rules section XIV B. See the
 Standing Rules and qualifying requirements in the current RMDS Omnibus.
- During the competition, the performance arenas will be open to hand walking only up to one half hour prior to the start of the first class. No horses will be allowed in the performance arenas during breaks. On Tuesday and Wednesday, priority will be given to arena setup and maintenance, however, schooling will be allowed on a limited basis.
- ALL dogs must be leashed and <u>attached</u> to a person or immovable object at all times! \$50 fine for all violations.
- Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current US
 Equestrian rulebook will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. USEquestrian rule 1402.1
- Open show entries accepted on first come first served basis, based on the postmark with dates on and between open and close dates. Mail only.
- Post entries accepted on first come first served basis with space available.
- Wait list will be maintained through Tuesday 8pm
- Management reserves the right to:
 - Add or cancel judges
 - Combine, divide, limit or cancel classes
 - Refuse entries.
 - Waive penalty fees
- NO SMOKING IN BARNS.
- Riders may compete in only ONE division, no cross entering divisions: You must choose either Open or Adult Amateur or Junior. Exception: you may cross enter into the GAIG/USDF Qualifying division.
- Schooling (out of competition) horses may be brought to the show but must be registered on an entry form, with signatures and appropriate fees. Areas where they may be ridden in will be restricted, and priority given to horses in competition. Check with the show office for details.
- All horses entered in competition must have a USDF HID or Lifetime registration. All riders and owners must have a USDF nonmember id, Group membership, or Participating membership. All riders and owners must also have a USEF membership or pay appropriate nonmember fees.

TIMES

Provisional ride times will be mailed to riders if a SASE is included with your entry and they will be posted at www.rmds.org, the Region V website www.usdfregion5.org, and www.twowhitefeet.com. Official times will be posted at the show office by noon on Wednesday. Please check for changes each show day – posted no later than one hour before first ride.

- INCLUDE WITH ENTRY;
 - For Test of Choice Classes, state level and division on entry blank.
 - Copies of RMDS/USDF/USEF membership cards MUST be included with entry.
 - A 2005 Coggins test is required.

REFUNDS

The office fee is non-refundable. Entries cancelled on or before the closing date will receive a refund of all fees except the office fee. No refunds if cancelled after the closing date unless ride is filled from waitlist. Waitlist maintained through Tuesday, September 20, 2005. No refunds of any kind for any reason from Wednesday 21 September through Sunday September 25, 2004.

GAIG/USDF REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

Riders placing in GAIG/USDF Regional Championship classes must be present, mounted and in full riding attire for award ceremonies. Failure, without prior permission of the competition manager, to be present and properly attired will eliminate the official score and placing and the next highest score will move up in placing.

ARENAS

- Outdoor arenas have all weather sand mix footing.
- All tests will be ridden in an outdoor 20x60 arena.
- Warm-up arenas have comparable footing.
- NO LUNGEING in warmup arenas except where designated, see grounds map in show office.
- Coaching may be done from the outside of the arenas ONLY.
- Competition arenas will be open for schooling on set-up day, Tuesday (before show weekend) until posted close time in show office.
