- 1) A copy of your 2017 RMDS Horse/Rider/ Owner card (if a member)
- 2) Adult Amateurs: A copy of your 2017 USEF AA card (Must also be on file at the RMDS Central Office)
- 3) Proof of negative Coggins taken within 2017.
- 4) Vaccine Record within 6 months

Owner, rider, horse memberships to RMDS must be current for scores to count towards qualifying for RMDS Championships and year-end awards. Post entries accepted if space is available. Send entries to the show secretary. \$30 bad check fee plus any collection/bank fees.

**REFUNDS:** Full refund up to closing date. After closing date, only the class fees will be refunded if the ride is filled. No refund due to acts of nature.

**AWARDS:** Both shows: Ribbons to be awarded through 6th place. High Point Award for training through FEI level, all three divisions (Open, Adult Amateur, JR/Young Rider) Classes will be separated, if enough entries.

**STABLING:** None

**TIMES:** Tentative times will be emailed - Secretary will **not** call ride times.

**ARENAS/FOOTING :** sand and clay mix

**OTHER:** Farrier/Vet on call. EMT will be on site during the show. ***NO DOGS!*** Any dog found will be confiscated and the owner charged \$50 as a donation to the Boulder County Humane Society.

**SCHOOLING:** Arena will be closed 1 hour prior to competition start. No schooling in the competition arena during breaks throughout the day. Hand walking on outside only with permission-lunge in lunging arena only

**Concessions:** **breakfast items and lunch will be available – limited menu.**

**All riders** must wear an ASTM approved helmet while mounted.

**DIRECTIONS:** Hwy 287 to Lookout Road – Turn East – 1<sup>st</sup> drive on left (north) (N 109<sup>th</sup> dead-ends into Lookout, directly across from driveway)
